Pastoral Care volunteers and Eucharistic ministers visit hospitals throughout the Diocese of Broken Bay providing comfort and care to Catholic patients. NSW Health requires that 40 hours of training is completed to perform this role. This new Diocesan Pastoral Care course is open to those who already volunteer in a hospital context and also those who might be deciding if they are suited to this ministry.

This one day a month free course will provide you with the required NSW Health Department training with a time commitment of one day per month for six months.
